

## PLAN YOUR VISIT

### Reservations

Reservations are required for all programs a minimum of 3 weeks in advance. Call 641.322.4717.

### Payments and Cancellations

Prepayment is required for some programs. To receive a refund for pre-paid programs, cancellations must be made 2 weeks prior to the program date. Programs operate rain or shine. All prices and times effective 01 July 2011 – 30 June 2012.

### Group Leaders

For Pre-K-Grade 1, one adult leader must accompany each group of five students. For grades 2-6, one adult leader must accompany each group of 10 students.

### Food

There is no food available on the site. Groups may bring their own 1800 era lunches (there is no refrigeration) to be eaten outside or in the school house, depending on the weather.

## **One Room School 2 hour program Pre-K-Grade 1**

Immerse your young students in a program tailored to their needs. Special activities focus on curriculum perfect for students in pre-school, kindergarten and first grade. Students are welcome to come in period dress and bring an appropriate 1800s lunch (no refrigeration).

12 students minimum/20 maximum, \$4.00 per student. One adult free with every five students. \$4.00 per each additional adult. Due to space limit, no more than 4 adults total. A reservation 3 weeks prior to program date and prepayment is required.

Bookings available to students, Monday through Friday, during September, October, April and May.



## **Visit to a One Room School 2 hour program Appropriate for Grades 2-6**

Take a step back in time as your class become students at the Icaria school roll playing the different ages that attended a one room school in the 1800s. This is an interactive experience of the 3 R's and playing popular school yard games that students will learn from and remember for a long time to come. Students may come in costume and bring an appropriate 1800s lunch (no refrigeration).

12 students minimum/20 maximum, \$4.00 per student. One adult free with every five students. \$4.00 per each additional adult. Due to space limit, no more than 4 adults total. A reservation 3 weeks prior to program date and prepayment is required.

Bookings available to students, Monday through Friday, during September, October, April and May.

## **A Day in the Life of an Icarian Student 4 hour program, 10 am – 2 pm Appropriate for grades 5 & 6**

This program gives young people the opportunity to explore what their lives might have been like in the Icaria Colony. They will spend time in the one-room school reading from McGuffey Readers, doing arithmetic problems, studying Icarian, and Adams County history, and more. When not in school, they will work at some of the jobs expected of the Icarian children, churn butter, make rope or work in the garden. Students may come in costume. They will need to bring an appropriate 1800s lunch (no refrigeration) to eat at mid-day.

12 students minimum/20 maximum, \$5.00 per student. One adult free with every five students. A reservation 3 weeks prior to program date and prepayment is required.

Bookings available to students, Monday through Friday, during September, October, April and May.
